GENERAL SAFETY AND INFORMATION

- Park in a space during drop off and pick up and walk your child into camp.
- Do not park your car during camp hours in the circle or during drop off and pick up.
- Children are not permitted to be in the parking lot by themselves during drop off and pick up. Please make sure you have your children firmly in hand during these times.
- Children are encouraged to arrive on time to start the day's activities with their peers at 9:30 a.m. Please do not drop off your child before 9:20 a.m. unless they are enrolled in before care.
- Parents are encouraged to pick up their children promptly at 4:00 pm unless after care arrangements have been made.

Children should come to camp with sunscreen already applied and extra to be applied for pool time.

We are pleased to let you know that many of our staff are certified in CPR and First Aid.

SUPPLY LIST

- Swim diapers for children who require them. Morning kiddie camp may use a sprinkler on weather permitting mornings. If your child stays for a whole day, please send in 2 swim diapers. We will hang the suits to dry for afternoon swim.

LUNCHES AND REFRESHMENTS

- ★ Kosher Dairy or Pareve only. (No meat lunches).
- Remember all foods brought to Gan Israel must have a proper Kosher symbol (others may be ok as well)



- We are a NUT-FREE Facility—products made in a factory that produces nut products or products that 'may contain traces of nuts' are OK to send for your child.
- Send in water bottles and juice boxes for lunch.
- We provide a snack and water during the day
 - After care children are encouraged to bring additional snacks.

ORIENTATION

There will be no official Camp Orientation this year.

Camp staff will be available on Sunday June 22 from 6:00-7:00 p.m. at the camp to answer any questions about the camp program.

You can also come at this time to drop off any forms and payment and to buy your child's camp t-shirt.

All campers will require a GREEN camp t-shirt for trips (Tuesday).

The cost for t-shirts will be \$10/each.

Shirts from other years will be sold for \$8/each for those that would like to purchase additional shirts for other days.

Sizes will be available on a first come first serve basis.

IMPORTANT FORMS

All necessary health, immunization, and emergency forms must be in camp prior to your child's first day of attendance.

If your child has any special needs or concerns, be sure to make the camp staff aware of them before your child attends the program.
